Refuse Collection	Find out when and where bin scheme is to start.	PCC have confirmed that new vehicles suitable for narrow access have been ordered. It is intended to introduce the new kerbside recycling service to the whole community between May – Dec 2014.
Footpaths/Rights of way	A number of the rights of way are being allowed to become blocked, overgrown or not reinstated after ploughing. Lack of footpath on A40 in Llanhamlach is a safety issue	Volunteers are being sought walk to the paths and report back to CC . Definitive maps showing ROW to be obtained so that each village has a copy for reference Matter presented to Highways Dept.
Repairs to PCC Roads	Complaints have been received concerning the state of the Square, Groesffordd Park and road between Groesffordd and Groesffordd Park Llanhamlach do not have a grit bin; merely a pile of grit. Repairs required to lay-by opposite Cantref Church	Repairs have been carried out to the square in Groesffordd and the road leading to Groesffordd Park. Request for a bin. Repairs and improvements are being done to the lay-by opposite Cantref Church.
Street Lighting	Street lights behaving erratically, going on and off at odd hours (Note: PCC has imposed a ration of only switching on half the lights in each community)	PCC has been asked to do a complete survey of street lighting in Groesffordd and Llanfrynach
Traffic	Speed through villages and C96 – Especially tractors. Stop signs or change of priority on C96/Groesffordd Rd/A40 slip road Llanhamlach – consider 50mph speed limit Nant Ddu – A470 – reduce speed limit	Cllr Liam Fitzpatrick contacting Powys CC road safety to discuss issues Llangors CC agree to work jointly with Llanfrynach CC. Car Parking	Complaints have been received regarding the inappropriate parking of cars in Groesffordd by visitors, inc. parking at junctions and on grass verges. Although no complaints were rcvd from residents in	The car parking in Groesffordd has been considered by the councillors and, although sympathetic to the issues raised, there would appear to be no immediate resolution to this matter as there is no land available to increase off road parking.

Playground Equipment	Request for the provision of playground equipment at Groesffordd for the children and grandchildren who visit the village.	We are looking at the cost of playground equipment
