Dear Dafydd

Thank you for your letter of 15 February regarding speed limits through Llanhamlach, Llanspyddid and Nant Ddu.

The statutory process involved in making a permanent order does take time and I understand that this can be frustrating. However, I do take road safety very seriously and can assure you that work is underway.

My officials are currently progressing the statutory consultation and design for the 50mph speed limit in Llanhamlach. The draft order is expected to be published in the spring and, subject to any responses, will be made by summer 2017. The 50mph speed limits at Nant Ddu and Llanspyddid are also expected to be in place during the next financial year. Details of these statutory consultations will be made available nearer the time.
