This accessibility statement applies to www.llanfrynach-community.org.uk. This website is run by Llanfrynach Community Council. The function of the website is to enable access to the minutes of the council, other statutory documents and to publish news items for the residents. We want everyone from the ward to be able to use this website and other interested people as well. For example, that means you should be able to:

- ! zoom in up to 300% without the text spilling off the screen
- ! navigate most of the website using just a keyboard
- ! navigate most of the website using speech recognition
- ! listen to most of the website using a screen reader (including VoiceOver)

We've also made the website text as simple as possible to understand.
