I am writing further to my acknowledgement letter of the 16th May 2014. I have now discussed your recent correspondence (enclosing the Community Council's Note on Traffic Safety in Llanhamlach) in further detail with Mr Salmon, who has asked me to respond to you on his behalf.

Mr Salmon understands your concerns and appreciates you bringing this matter to his attention.

He would indeed be happy to support the community of Llanhamlach and your efforts in the actions being taken to deal with the traffic safety issues in the area.

However, as you rightly note, Mr Salmon has stressed that it is the Trunk Roads Agency, in consultation with the Police, who make the decisions on speed limits. Such decisions do not fall under Mr Salmon's jurisdiction.

Matters concerning road safety are a priority for Mr Salmon, and he has been rigorously scrutinising police and partner efforts to address community concerns. Information from our communities is key to keeping him informed, and as such, I thank you for taking the time to contact the Commissioner.
